The 25th edition of the Annual Scientific Meeting of the Italian Association of Management Engineering (AiIG) will take place in Bologna, on 16-17 October 2014, at MAST, Manifattura di Arti Sperimentazione e Tecnologia (<http://mast.org>), via Speranza 42, and at the site of the Department of Management, located in the School of Engineering, of the University of Bologna, in Via Terracini 28 (<http://www.scienzeaziendali.unibo.it>).

- Thematic tracks, 17 October – afternoon;
- Parallel Sessions, 16 October – afternoon and 17 October – morning;
- Annual Members' meeting – following the parallel sessions on 16 October;
- Pagliarani Award, 16 October – afternoon within the Annual Members' meeting;
- Social dinner, 16 October – evening.

CONFERENCE THEME

The 25th Annual Scientific Meeting theme is **The future of manufacturing, the manufacturing of the future**. On top of papers addressing the theme of the conference, **contributions from all the research domains of the AiIG scientific community** are welcome. This *Call for Papers* encourages the submission of *extended abstracts* and *full papers* to both the general conference and specific thematic tracks.

The selected *tracks* address the following topics:

1. Integration across boundaries: facing the complexity of new organizational arrangements;
2. Public procurement re-examined: policies, innovation, entrepreneurship, operations;
3. Boosting economic growth: entrepreneurship and corporate entrepreneurship in manufacturing and related industries;
4. Innovation in entrepreneurial finance;
5. Universities as the engine of growth

PAGLIARANI AWARD

In memory of Professor Giorgio Pagliarani, the first president of the Italian Association of Management Engineering, a Best Paper Award has been established. To be eligible for the award, we ask for *full papers* not previously published, which must be submitted **no later than 30 June 2014**. **The papers cannot be co-authored by associate or full professors**. The winning paper will be presented in the plenary session.

WORK SUBMISSION

Extended abstracts and *full papers* should be submitted to the following email address:

In case of a submission to a thematic track, we ask the authors to indicate in the **email subject** the number and the title of the selected track.

The *extended abstract* must be 5-6 pages in length (A4 paper and 2.5 cm margins, Times New Roman 12 and 1.5 spacing). *Full papers* must be no more than 30 pages in length (A4 paper and 2.5 cm margins, Times New Roman 12 and 1.5 spacing).

In the first page, the contributions should report the title, the names of the authors and their affiliation, the name and address of the corresponding authors, and up to five keywords.

As for the extended abstracts, the following structure is suggested: 1. Introduction; 2. Relevance of the research; 3. Contribution, 4. Method; 5. Description of results; 6. Bibliography (no more than 15 citations). With the exception of the first page, the submissions should not report the names of the authors.

The evaluation of all submissions will be anonymous. Acceptance could be conditional to revisions which will be communicated to authors in due time.

CONFERENCE PROCEEDINGS

The selected papers will be available on the conference website. The papers, to be included in the conference proceedings, require that at least one of the authors is registered at the conference.
